- Application form
- Student personal essay – on topic “Why I want to attend AusPREP.”
- Grade report – Applicants should have a B or better average in their academic courses, especially in mathematics and science.
- 3 recommendations: math teacher, science teacher, and school counselor/assistant principal.

Applications will be due by the end of March 2018, and can be submitted by mail, email, or fax. Application acceptances are sent out by the end of April. Generally, applications that meet the requirements are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis.
