Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called "verification". The law (34 CFR, Part 668) says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on the FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Administrator will compare your FAFSA data with your 2020 Tax Return Transcript and/or other financial documents. If there are differences between your FAFSA data and financial documents, we may need to correct your FAFSA. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form to the Office of Financial Aid within **10 business days** so that your financial aid will not be delayed. We may ask for additional documents after you submit the verification worksheet.
