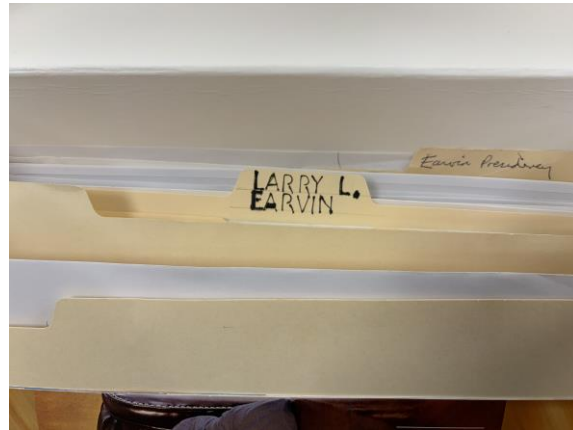

Biographical Notes:

Dr. Larry L. Earvin was the President of Huston-Tillotson University from 2000-2015. Dr. Earvin earned his bachelor's degree in business administration at Clark College, a master's degree in urban planning from Georgia State University, and a doctorate in American studies from Emory University. Immediately before coming to Huston-Tillotson College, Dr. Earvin was dean of the school of Arts and Science at Clark Atlanta University. He has served organization as American Academy of Political Science, American Association of Higher Education, New York University's Faculty Resource Network, and the U.S. Department of Commerce's National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration

consortium of HBCU and historically disadvantaged institutions in South Africa. Dr. Earvin also served as a senior academic advisor to Project Kaleidoscope, a Washington-based concern that promoted innovation in science education. Co-author of numerous papers and publications, Dr. Earvin is a frequent recipient of awards and fellowships.

During his fifth year and the institution's 130th anniversary, Dr. Earvin moved Huston-Tillotson to university status. In addition, he guided the university through successful 2002 and 2010 reaffirmation visits; fulfilled the vision to renovate the Amthony and Louise Viaer-Alumni Hall. In 2011, following eleven years of enrollment increases, HT reached its highest enrollment to date and graduated from its largest class in 2012.
