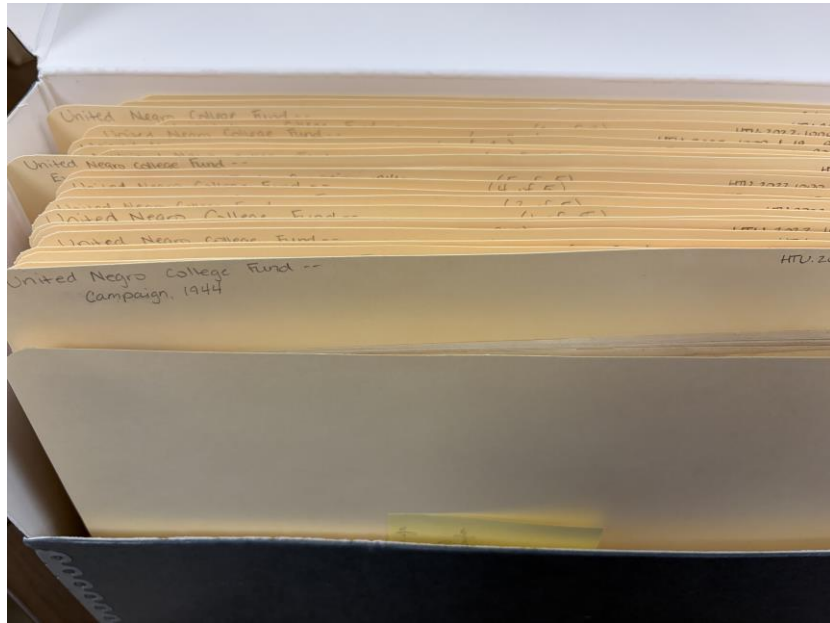

### Biographical Notes:

More than 80 years ago a college president, Dr. Frederick D. Patterson, had a vision for the future of small, private black colleges like his own. He shared his vision with 26 other presidents, convincing them that there was strength in their numbers. United, they could have more impact by appealing to Americans for dollars to support higher education for African American. The United Negro College, Fund Inc. (UNCF) is a symbol of that unity.

Founded in 1944, UNCF has grown to become one of the nation's leading higher education assistance organizations. UNCF nowadays is awarding more than 11,000 students scholarships, worth more than \$62 million each year; providing financial support to 37 historically Black colleges and universities (HBCUs); and serving as the nation's leading advocate for the importance of minority education and community engagement. As a member college, Huston-Tillotson University maintains a good and long relationship with UNCF.
