Biographical Notes:

Dr. John Jarvis Seabrook was the President of Huston-Tillotson College from 1955 to 1965. He received his early training in the public schools in Savannah, Georgia and Claflin College in Orangeburg, South Carolina. Dr. Seabrook gained his A.B. at Clark College, he later obtained L. M. degree from Boston University, and J.D. from Howard University.

Dr. Seabrook has been engaged in the work of various organizations. For example, he worked Christian education for approximately four decades, having served as Director of the Social Science Division at Samuel Huston College; as Chaplain, Dean of Men, and Business Manager at Langston University, Langston, Oklahoma; as Director of the Morgan College Christian Center, and Professor of Philosophy at Morgan State College, Baltimore, Maryland. And for ten years as President of Claflin University, Orangeburg, South Carolina. During his presidency at Huston-Tillotson College. Six buildings were erected, and the institution received unqualified accreditation with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Upon his retirement he was named President-Emeritus, he left in the College's Building Fund \$300,000.00.

Dr. Seabrook has served as a delegate to two World Councils on Methodism: 1957, Springfield, Massachusetts; and 1961, Oslo, Norway. He has been a delegate to three General Conferences, and four Jurisdictional Conferences of The United Methodist Church. He has traveled extensively in Europe, and he has visited Mexico, Canada, Hawaii and the Bahama Islands. Dr. Seabrook was invited by the late President Lyndon B. Johnson to witness the signing of H.R.9567 at Southwest Texas State University. Dr. Seabrook was also a member of Austin's first Committee on Human Relations and other various organizations in the city.
